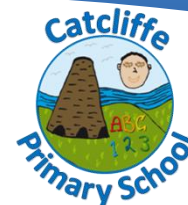




Catcliffe Primary School

Dinner Money

Dinner money is still **£2.05** per day this year. This will therefore mean that a full week is £10.25. **Please ensure school dinners are paid for in advance and not after the meals have been provided.** Children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 are eligible for Universal Free School Meals. Children in Nursery, Years 3 and above will need to pay for school dinners unless they are eligible, and have applied for free school meals. All payments are collected by the school and cheque's should now be made payable to Catcliffe Primary School.

Milk Money

Children up to 5 years of age are eligible for free milk at school. Any other pupils, older than 5, still have the option for milk but will need to pay a small charge of 15p per day. **We now collect payment each half term** based on the number of days in the half term period. The cost for the full year is £28.80. If you are interested in your child having milk daily please contact Mrs McComb in Reception.

Children in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and 2 of age are eligible for a free piece of fruit each day. Fruit is available for all other children at morning break at a small cost of 20p per portion.

Parent Permissions letter

Next week children in year 1 to Year 6 will be bringing home a 7 page letter which will need completing and returning to school. This is a very important document that includes emergency contact and other important details required for the schools 'Student Information Management' database. The information is confidential and includes your permission for your child to take part in curriculum activities and school trips throughout the year. Could you please complete and return to school as soon as possible.

If the document is not returned then your child will not be able to attend school visits or activities.
